A wide range of guided tours and excursions await you in Würzburg, allowing you to experience the most interesting and beautiful facets of the city from different perspectives – either as part of a public tour, with a private guide, or in a group. The range of tours on offer includes everything from informative tours of the Old Town to enjoyable wine, culinary and cultural history tours, as well as boat trips on the river Main to Veitshöchheim Palace.

Our tour guides are knowledgeable, well-trained locals who love their city and are keen to share their passion. The themed tours are fascinating and cover

many aspects of the city's history, from "Women in Würzburg" to "Jewish Life in the City".

For guests who want to explore Würzburg on a public guided tour, the "Würzburg's Wine Bridge: Sips & Sights" offers the ideal opportunity every Saturday from May to October. At the end of the tour, you can enjoy a glass of Franconian wine on the Old Main Bridge. If you don't want to explore Würzburg on foot, you can simply book a city tour with the City Train. The small, slow-moving train offers a great overview of important sights such as the Residence, the cathedral and Marienberg Fortress.

## WÜRZBURG – CENTER OF FRANCONIAN WINE

Surrounded by famous vineyards along the banks of the river Main, sun-drenched slopes shape the image of the city, its culture and its people. Wine estates, some of which date back to the Middle Ages, have played a major role in the city's history – most notably the Juliusspital winery, established in 1576, the Bürgerspital founded in 1316, and the Staatlicher Hofkeller, which dates back to 1128 and is one of the oldest wine estates in the world. In Würzburg, wine culture is not only enjoyed by the glass and from the Bocksbeutel bottle. Franconian wine defines the character and customs,

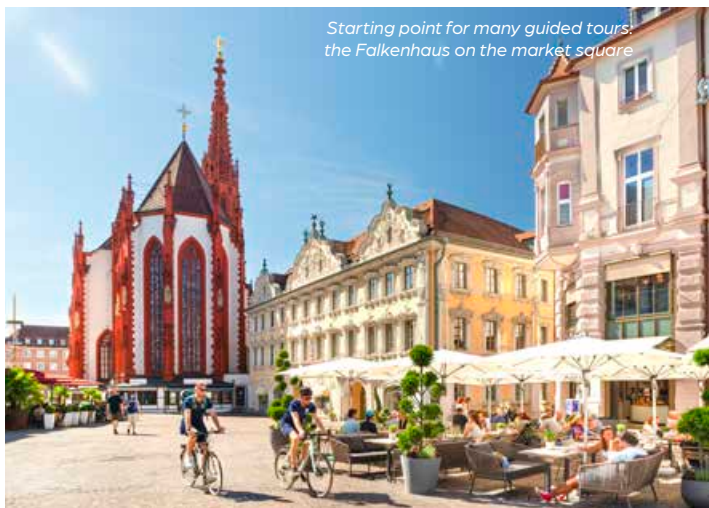
cuisine and hospitality, festivals and facets of city life, which revolve around socializing and lifestyle.

## ALL ROADS LEAD TO WINE!

Würzburg is a city that lives and breathes wine. The “Brückenschoppen” has even become a term in its own right. It is a local expression for enjoying a glass of wine in a relaxed atmosphere on the Old Main Bridge. Our suggestion: do the same! You can try a wide selection of local wines in the stylish wine shops of the traditional wineries and buy them on the spot. The “Würzburg Wine Pass” invites you to taste three exquisite wines in some of the city's most

beautiful wine bars and tasting rooms, and is an excellent way to combine a self-guided city tour with customized wine tasting. The popular “Würzburg City Highlights walking tour & wine” and the cellar tours and wine tastings at the

renowned Bürgerspital wine estate are aimed particularly at groups.

The highlights of the wine year are the indulgent Würzburg wine festivals from mid-May to early September. Where people know how to make wine, others who have dedicated themselves to hospitality are not far behind: Würzburg’s gastronomy is truly vibrant – and revolves around its appreciation of wine. If you want to experience Franconian culinary delights, you will find traditional and regional dishes in many restaurants and wine taverns. Of course, modern cuisine has also long since found its way to the river Main. Würzburg’s gastronomic scene has something to offer for every palate.

## UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE RESIDENCE PALACE

The residence of the Würzburg prince-bishops was built between 1720 and 1744 according to plans by Balthasar Neumann. It is today one of the most important Baroque palace complexes in Europe. The Residence is surrounded by the Court Garden, and the entire complex has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1981. The guided tour starts in the Garden Hall and then takes you to the impressive grand staircase. Marvel at the enormous dome and the unique, 677 m<sup>2</sup> ceiling fresco by the Venetian artist G.B. Tiepolo. Then wander through the White Hall and the beautiful stuccowork by Antonio Bossi to the Imperial Hall.

## MARIENBERG FORTRESS


Fortress Marienberg is visible from seemingly everywhere and is the symbol of the city of Würzburg as well as a testimony to more than 1000 years of history. Despite construction work, the second courtyard, the so-called Echterhof, and the viewing points around the castle remain accessible. The moat offers a magnificent view of the old town. The regular guided tours of the castle continue to take place and provide an insight into the eventful history of the fortress.

## PALACE VEITSHÖCHHEIM

The summer palace of the Würzburg prince-bishops is located in one of the most important rococo gardens in Germany. The prince-bishops' living quarters and the guest apartment on the upper floor are particularly worth seeing. These rooms can only be visited as part of a guided tour. There is an exhibition on the history of the rococo gardens on the first floor, which can be visited without a guided tour.
